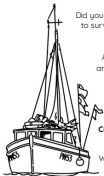

Why Are Lobsters Habitat Heroes?

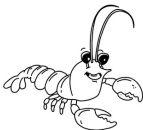
Lobsters are important members of the marine ecosystem because they:

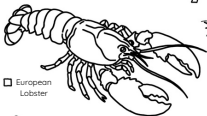

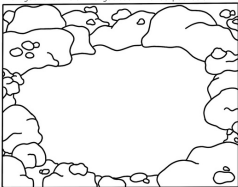
